


TULIPA



PAULA SCHIAVON was born in Porto Alegre, in the south of Brazil. She is the winner of the 29th Açorianos Literature Prize in the children's category. Her books have been awarded the UNESCO Chair and the FNLIJ "Highly Recommended" distinctions. Loba was selected for the White Ravens catalogue, and in 2024, she was chosen as an illustrator for the 15th Iberoamérica Ilustra Catalogue. She was a finalist at the Bologna Children's Book Fair, in 2025, with her series Collections.








JIDDO

Trained as a physician and specialized in cardiology, she began developing her artistic technique intuitively as a way to foster communication and learning for her son Luca — who lives with the rare Jacobsen Syndrome. In addition to being an illustrator and content creator, she is a preceptor at IDOMED Medical School and teaches art workshops. She currently lives in Rio de Janeiro.



The competition between the two teams—already fierce—grows even stronger with the arrival of Lefty, a dog who plays left-wing for Our Team, and reaches its peak in a match that will remain forever in the memory of everyone involved. In the lighthearted and witty prose of master storyteller Luis Fernando Verissimo, this is a tale that captures the simplicity and joy of street soccer.



LUIS FERNANDO VERISSIMO (1936–2025) was one of the greatest figures in Brazilian literature, known for his humorous and observant style. A passionate Internacional supporter, he brings together in O *cachorro bom de bola* two passions that marked his career: football and humor.

CLÁUDIO PAIVA began working as a cartoonist at the newspaper O Pasquim in 1976. His career as an illustrator, cartoonist, comic artist, writer and screenwriter is extensive in major newspapers and magazines. In 2023 he published *Chico and the Smelly Pirates* (Abacatte editions), his first book for children.



Among her children's books are Mamãe Está Cansada (Companhia das Letrinhas, 2023) and A Grande Invenção (FTD, 2025), among others.




HOLE





TERESA CÁRDENAS is a writer, actress, storyteller, and social worker. She is a member of the Writers' Association of the Union of Writers and Artists of Cuba. The many awards she has received establish her as one of the most important voices in Cuban literature. Among her books are *Cartas para a minha mãe*, *Awon Baba*, and *Cachorro velho* (Casa de las Américas Prize, 2005), published in Cuba, Canada, the United States, Sweden, South Korea, and Brazil — released in Brazil by Pallas Editora. Her stories appear in various anthologies, and her work is a reference for literary essays and academic theses in countries such as Cuba, the United States, Colombia, Venezuela, and Brazil.







On the shores of Lake Tanganyika, in Congo, Jelani and Che Guevara meet amid the struggle between burning houses. In this harsh setting, "farewell is a place where even a guerrilla can get lost," and a dog longs for the "scent of a hug."

Ondjaki's text was created based on António Jorge Gonçalves' moving illustrations, which offer a brief tribute to the woodcut artist J. Borges.



ONDJAKI was born in Luanda in 1977. He is a prose writer and sometimes a poet. He has won the Sagrada Esperança Award (2004), the Grand Short Story Prize (2007), the Grinzane – Young African Writer Award (2008), the FNLIJ – Juvenile Award (2010), and the Jabuti – Juvenile Award (2010). He is a member of the Angolan Writers' Union. His books have been translated into dozens of languages. He lives between Angola and Brazil.










